



4th Street Enhancements Project Phase II Expect Delays - Reduced Lanes on 4th Street between Olympic Dr./Blvd. and Colorado Ave.

Start Date: Monday November 7th, 2022

Estimated phase duration: 2 and a half weeks

Work Hours: Mon-Fri 9AM-4PM

Location: 4th St between Colorado Ave and Olympic Drive / Blvd. (see the map below)

Dear Neighbors:

The City of Santa Monica has contracted with Access Pacific, Inc., for the 4th Street Enhancements Project Phase II. Beginning on Monday November 7th, 2022 for approximately 2 and a half weeks, two southbound traffic lanes will be reduced to a single southbound lane and two northbound traffic lanes will be reduced to a single northbound lane on 4th Street between Colorado Ave and the Olympic Dr./ Blvd. from 9AM to 4PM for work relating to street light improvements.



Construction Period:

This phase of work is anticipated to last 2 and a half weeks from Nov. 7th until Nov. 23rd, 2022. Please note that the start and completion time/date of construction may be delayed due to unforeseen conditions and weather. Contractor will be operating heavy equipment, which is necessary for this work with intermittent loud noises.

Community Impacts:

- Expected delays and allow additional travel time, due to reduced lanes.
- At least one lane of traffic in each direction on 4th Street will be maintained at all times.
- All driveways, businesses and Civic Center Parking Structure will remain accessible at all times
- Off- and on-ramps may be temporary be reduced to one single lane at various points throughout the project
- Temporary sidewalk closures will be limited to one side of the street at a time to maintain pedestrian access along 4th Street
