City's Five-Year Water and Wastewater Rate Study.

The rate structure, implemented over the next five years, is planned to ensure a long-term, safe, reliable and affordable water supply for Santa Monica residents and businesses. It is also a key component to eliminating our City's reliance on imported water supplies and delivering water self-sufficiency by 2023. A background on our City's water system, how our rates are calculated, and information on the findings of the rate study findings will be presented; with q&a to follow.
